

# Summer League 2019

## Rulebook Expansion

### Registration

1. Players must be 18+ years old to participate in the games.
2. All players and teams must be registered in LBN Platform.  
<https://www.londonbasketballnation.co.uk/>. Information and manuals on how to do so will be provided by LBN before and during the league.
3. All players and teams must be registered before they can participate in a game.
4. LBN will have “Registry points” in the venue during the first 2 Fixtures (July 6th and July 13th) to help teams and players through the registration process.
5. LBN will register all the players registered within its platform in London Region Registrar system and get a Membership number for them.  
If the player has an active Membership number you must provide it to LBN personnel or fill it in your profile page on LBN platform.
6. All players must bring a form of ID that contains a picture and their full name in classical Latin alphabet to the first game they play, so game Officials can identify the players.  
LBN staff might take a picture of the players’ faces to keep in its records, this is to ensure that players don’t have to bring ID or BE Membership Cards every time they play and LBN officials don’t have to iterate the process every game.
7. Player registration closes on August 4th. No new players may be added to participating teams thereafter.

## Player trades/Borrows

1. Teams within the same Club can borrow up to two players per team per game from other teams.

As an example: Team A has a game against Team B, Team A can use up to 2 players from Team C for that game, as long as those 2 players are registered appropriately in Team C as per the "Registration" section of this Rulebook.

This rule does not apply for Playoff games in which no borrows are allowed.

2. Trades among teams are allowed till August 4th as long as players are registered on the proper team as per the "Registration" section of this Rulebook.
